Spend for wildlife

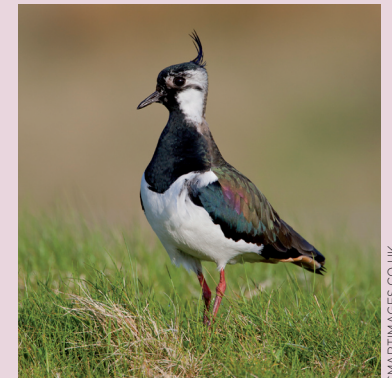
